REGULATION 4.2: EMERITUS TITLES AND HONORARY DOCTORATES

A. President Emeritus

1. A former President of the University who has rendered exemplary and meritorious service to the University may be conferred the President Emeritus title with the approval of the Board of Trustees.
2. The President Emeritus title is a life-long honorary distinction which provides no remuneration or service benefits to the conferee. The title does not confer automatic membership to any University body nor the power to exercise any administrative or executive function.
3. The Board of Trustees may call upon a President Emeritus to provide counsel or serve in various roles for the benefit and enhancement of the University. The conferee may also be re-appointed to continue service with the University in a defined role. Any compensation and related service benefits (if applicable) for such engagement shall be decided by the University.

B. Emeritus Professors

1. The Provost may approve the conferral of the title of Emeritus Professor on a faculty member, normally one who is retiring from service. The title is conferred in recognition of distinguished scholarship and exemplary service and contributions to the University and for which continued association is deemed meritorious.
2. The Emeritus Professor title is a life-long honorary distinction which provides no remuneration or service benefits to the conferee. The title does not confer automatic membership to any University body nor the power to exercise any administrative or executive function.
3. The President or the Provost may call upon an Emeritus Professor to participate in and contribute to the academic life of the University, as pertaining to research, teaching, as well as service and mentorship.

C. Honorary Degrees

1. The Chancellor may confer Honorary Degrees to deserving individuals such as those who have attained prominence or have made outstanding contributions in research, science and any other field of endeavour, community service or service to the University.
2. Conferral or revocation of Honorary Degrees shall be approved by the Board of Trustees and the Ministry of Education on the recommendation by the President's Council.
