The NTU-USP Scholarship is offered to students with strong academic credentials. As a scholarship recipient, you can look forward to the following benefits:

- Full coverage of subsidised tuition fees (after Tuition Grant).
- Living allowance of S\$6,500 per academic year.
- Accommodation allowance of up to S\$2,000 per academic year (applicable to scholarship holders who reside in NTU hostels only).
- Computer allowance of S\$2,000 (one-off).
- Travel Grant of up to S\$8,000 for an overseas study/attachment programme subject to terms and conditions in the Travel Grant Form.





Broad-based Holistic Learning

The NTU-USP provides an intellectually stimulating environment for students who are enrolled in the programme. NTU-USP students sharpen their critical thinking skills and leadership abilities through interdisciplinary academic and co-curricular programmes promising independent learning and immersive intercultural experiences.

This academically rigorous multi-disciplinary programme complements and bridges NTU's core disciplines. adding breadth to each scholar's academic experience. Scholars remain in their home programme while concurrently pursuing NTU-USP courses and activities.



Students admitted to the programme are required to undertake four compulsory core courses in their freshmen year:

- Fieldwork and Documentation: Topics in Sustainability (Travel Overseas Programme for Scholars (TOPS))
- Livina Well
- Writing and Reasoning

From their second year onwards, students are expected to complete elective modules from any of the two categories:

- Arts, Humanities and Culture (AHC)
- Science, Technology and Society (STS)

Global Opportunities

On top of the core module Travel Overseas Programme for Scholars (TOPS) with compulsory travel, students have the opportunity to choose from various overseas experiential programmes, including the NTU-USP Study Abroad Programme, NTU's Overseas Exchange Programme (GEM Explorer), and Electives with Overseas Components. In addition, students also have the option to participate in short-term programmes, such as winter or summer programmes under OGEM. These initiatives present diverse opportunities for students to gain valuable international experiences as an integral part of their academic journey.
