Legal Profile Setup

- The issuance of a Tax Invoice is mandatory for transactions involving GST-registered customers, as it serves as crucial documentation for their input tax claims on standard-rated purchases.
- A Tax Invoice is not required in instances of <u>zero-rated</u>, <u>exempt</u>, or deemed supplies, or when the customer is not registered for GST.

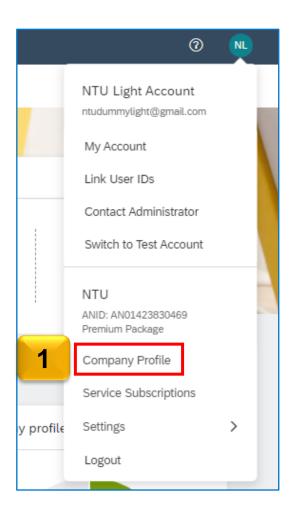


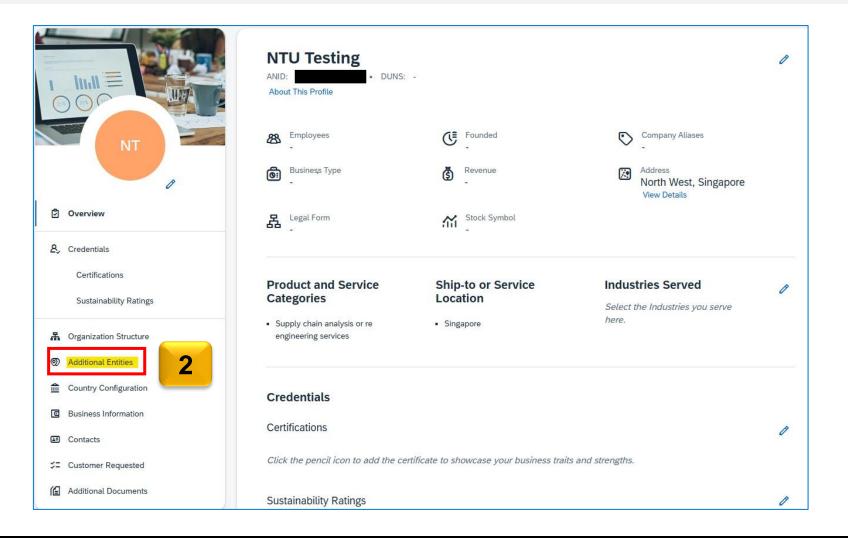




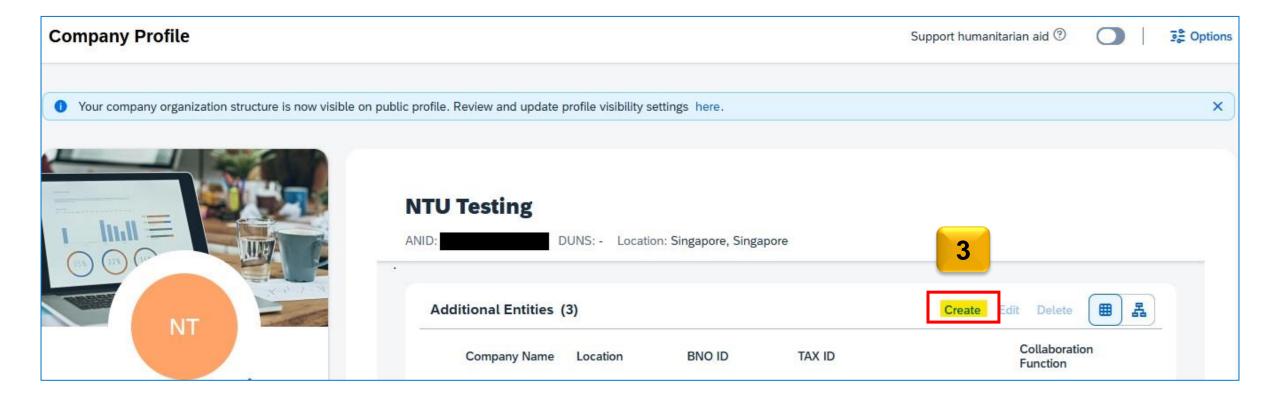


- 1. In the top right corner of your account, click [user initials] > Company Profile.
- 2. Click "Additional Entities" in the left column of the Company Profile page.

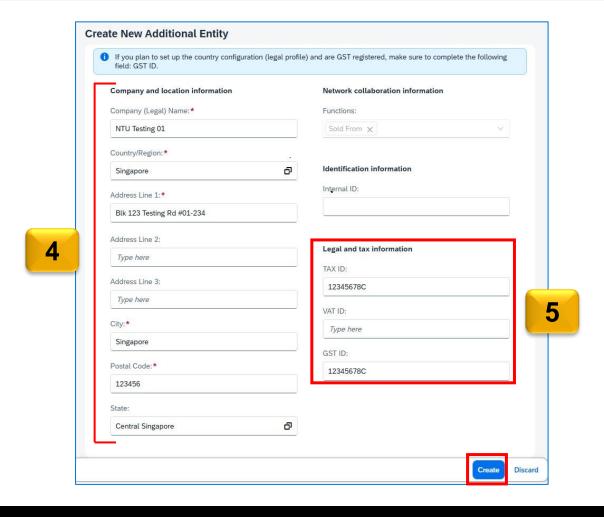




3. In the "Additional Entities" section, click "Create" to set up the legal profile.

- 5. Input **Tax ID** (UEN number) and **GST ID**; leave the GST ID field blank if your company does not have one. Click "**Create**" to finalize the additional entity/address.



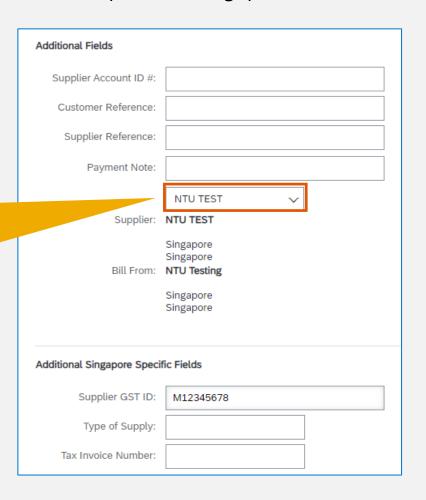
Create Additional Entities - for Overseas Suppliers (GST-Registered with IRAS)

Overseas suppliers with a GST-registered entity in Singapore should input their Singapore address details.

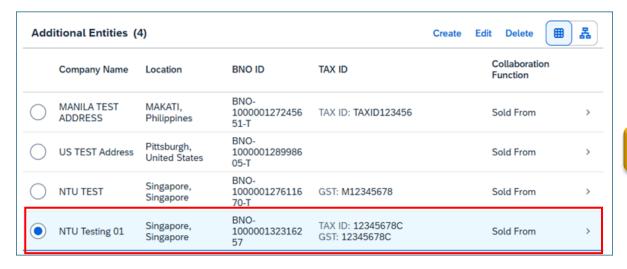
When creating an E-Invoice, always select the **correct address** from the

"**Additional Fields**"

dropdown menu to ensure the Tax Invoice is generated with the accurate profile.



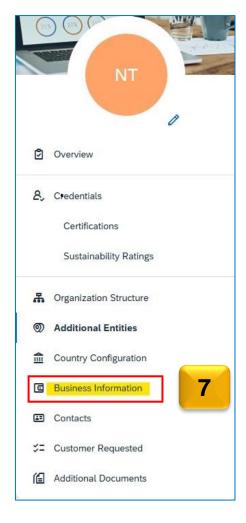
- You should now see the Additional Entities has been added.
- 7. To ensure that the Tax ID auto-populates on the invoice, click on the "Business Information" tab.



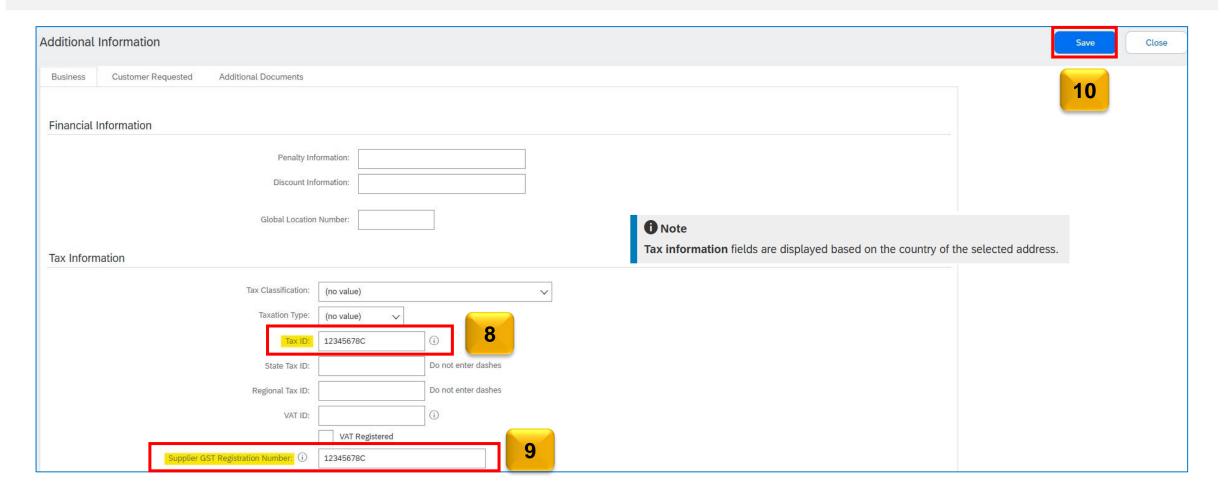


Note:

- · "Supplier (SoldFrom)" is selected by default on the Functions dropdown under Network collaboration information.
- An existing address cannot be edited or deleted if it is linked to a country configuration. To edit the entity, the country configuration needs to be deleted first in the Company Profile's Country Configuration.
- The maximum number of additional entities that can be added to a company profile is 20.



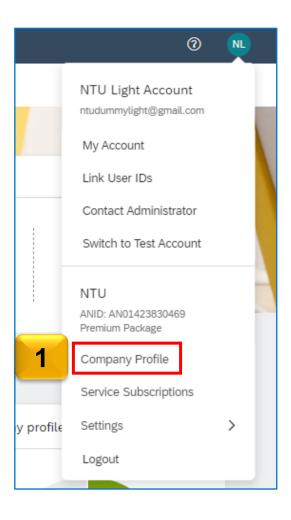
- 8. **GST-registered suppliers in Singapore**: Enter your GST registration number in both the "**Tax ID**" and "**Supplier GST Registration Number**" fields.
- Non-GST registered suppliers: Enter "Not Applicable" in both fields.
- 10. Click Save.

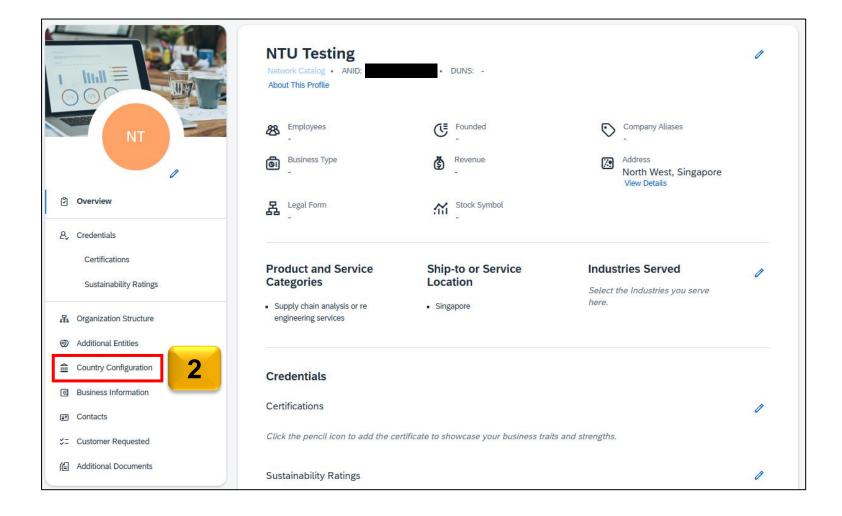




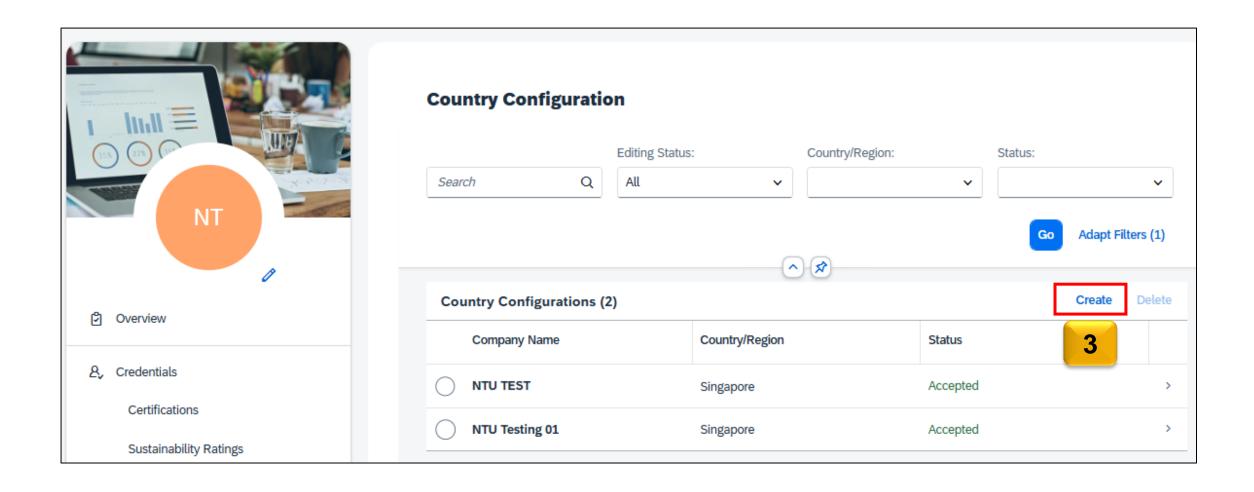


- 1. Navigate to top right corner of your account, click [user initials] > Company Profile.
- 2. Select Country Configuration from the left navigation pane.



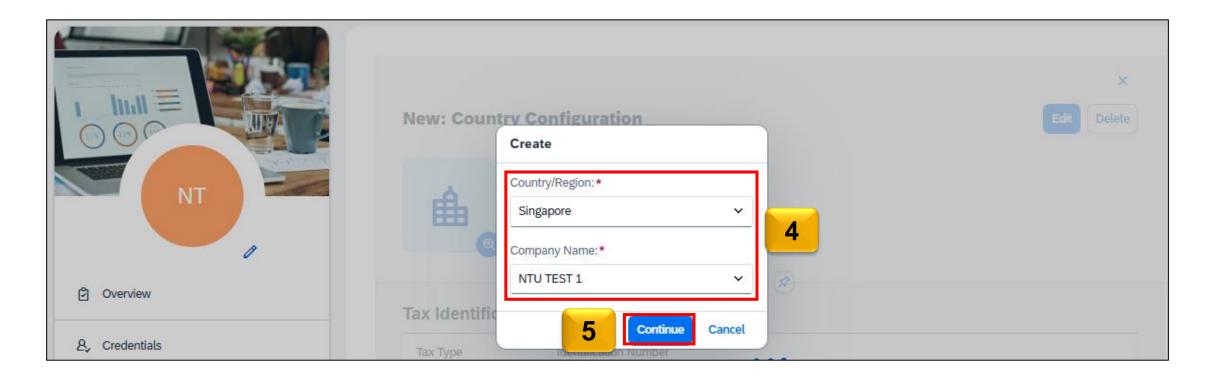


3. Choose Create.

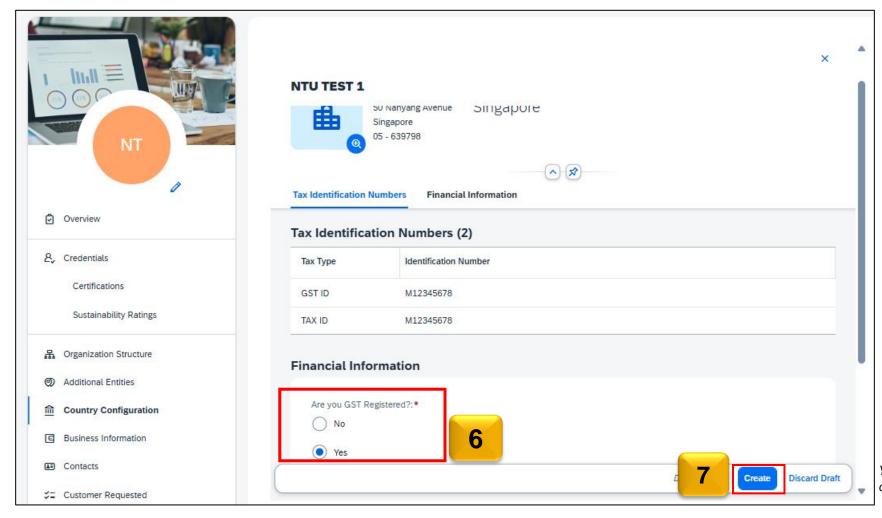


- Select the Country/Region as Singapore and the Company Name.

For the selected country and company name, some of the fields are prepopulated. This information is captured from the company details provided under Additional Entities.



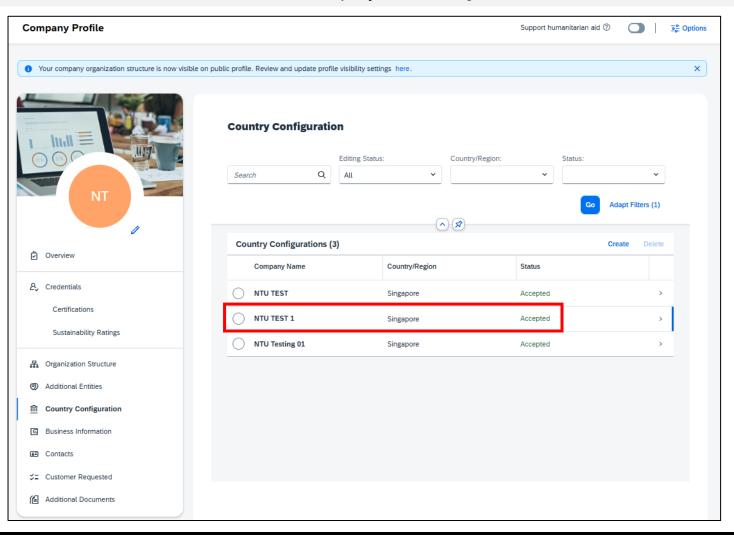
- 6. In the Financial Information section, choose your option for the question Are you GST registered?
