Update of animal researcher profiles on ERMP

25-30 June 2025

As per Singapore's **NACLAR Guidelines** (2nd Ed.):

"IV.3.9 Individuals with a hands-on practice lapse of 2 or more years should attend hands-on refresher training or assessment of competency".

To support institutional and individuals' compliance with this requirement, NTU-IACUC will be updating each animal user's ERMP profile with competencies acquired through RCULA/RCUF practical training and assign a 2-year validity to each competency.

This update will take place between <u>25 and 30 June</u>. During this period, ERMP notifications will be sent to animal users whose competencies are expiring soon or have expired.

If you receive this ERMP notification, please access the ServiceNow link included in the notification to update last performed dates for the expired competencies and submit the declaration form for approval.
