UNCONSENTED AI EXPERIMENT ON REDDIT SPARKS ETHICAL OUTRAGE



Researchers from the University of Zurich ran a covert experiment on subreddit, **r/ChangeMyView(CMV)**, to study if AI bots are able to influence user opinions.

The bots, posing as real users, analysed comment histories and posted more than 1,700 replies. This study, performed without consent from participants, was condemned by Reddit and its moderators as unethical, leading to a ban on the researchers.

A university investigation resulted in a formal warning to the investigators, who did not adhere to their IRB's recommendations. The incident raises serious concerns on the ethics of AI-driven research.

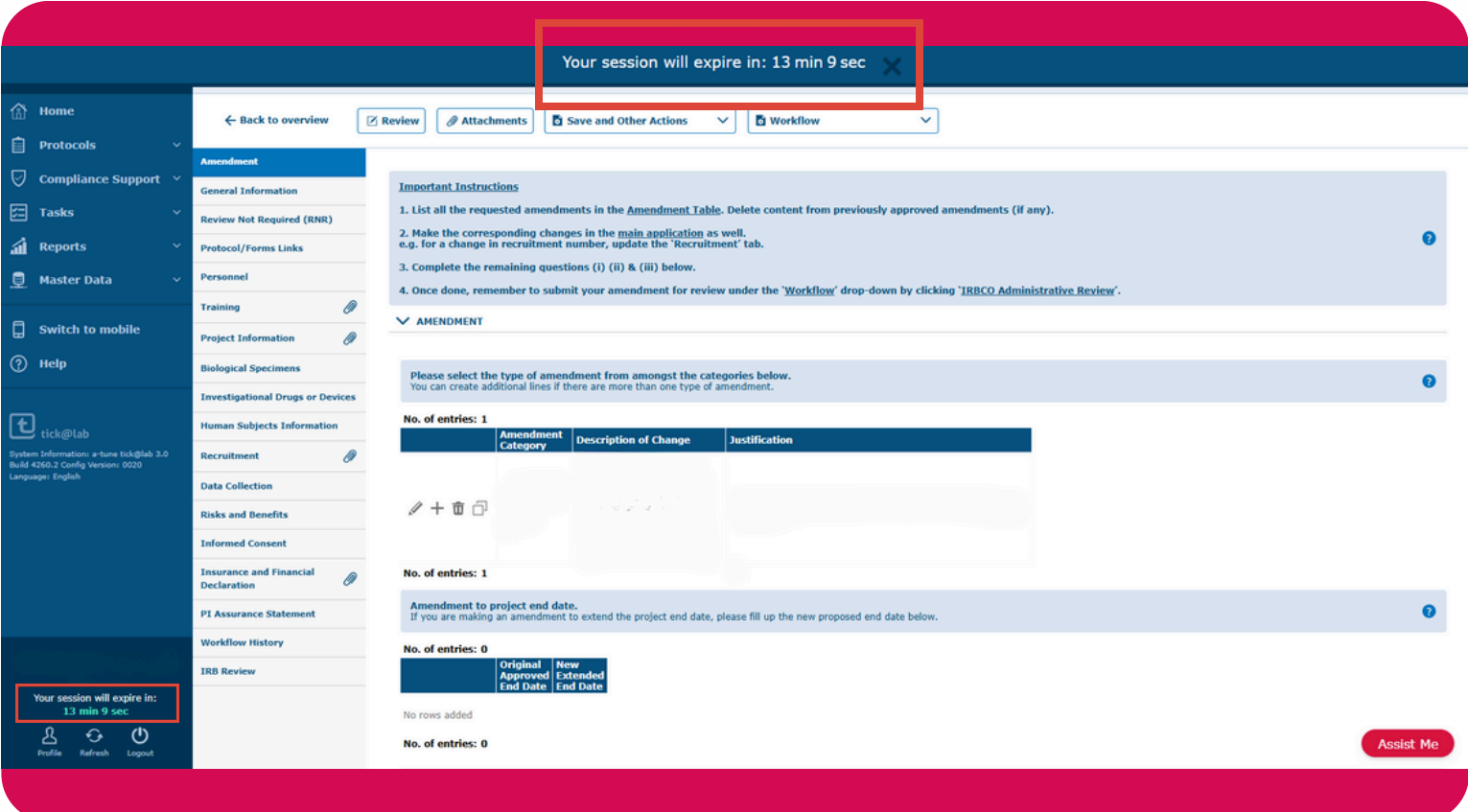

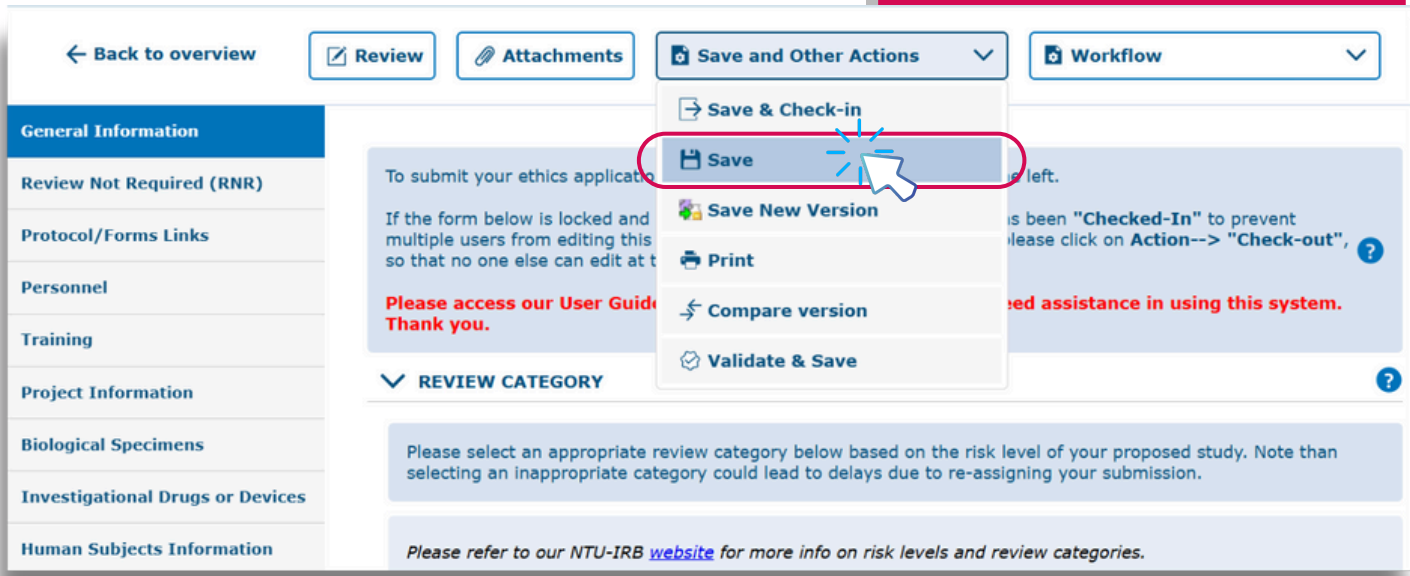
