Heng Dean is an advisor to nature tech platform Arkadiah.

Heng Dean was previously a Managing Director with climate change investment and advisory firm Pollination, where he oversees its business in Southeast Asia.

Prior to Pollination, Heng Dean spent 11 years with investment firm Temasek, where he worked on sustainability and climate issues, including helping to set up GenZero, a S\$5 billion investment platform wholly owned by Temasek that focuses on carbon markets and decarbonization.

Heng Dean was also a Senior Advisor on Carbon Markets and Sustainability with Indonesian listed company PT Triputra Agro Persada, and a member of the advisory board with Yayasan Konservasi Alam Nusantara, which is the Indonesian affiliate of The Nature Conservancy.

Heng Dean started his career with the Singapore Ministry of Foreign Affairs and was a First Secretary at the Singapore Embassy in Jakarta. He has a B.Sc. in Accounting and Finance from the London School of Economics and an MBA from INSEAD.
