NEWRI OSHE Policy

- Continually review the infrastructural facilities and research projects to address risks as well as the prevention to environmental pollution;
- Provide appropriate resources to achieve the intent of this policy.
- Strive for continual improvements to NEWRI OSH management system (OSHMS).
