MASTER OF ARTS (Applied Psychology)

The Master of Arts (Applied Psychology) aims to produce graduates who will become leaders in the field of psychological practice.

It is designed to provide theoretical knowledge and research insights as well as practical skills to interested individuals who have the pre-requisite qualifications to train as specialists in the field of Educational Psychology or Counselling Psychology. It also provides graduates with training towards becoming Registered Psychologists in Singapore.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE & CONTENT

The programme offers the specialisations of Educational Psychology and Counselling Psychology. Successful applicants are only offered one specialization and cannot switch specializations during the course of the programme.

Awards at the National Institute of Education are structured in terms of Academic Units (AU). The Master of Arts (Applied Psychology) comprises 57 AUs. With effect from <u>January 2025</u>, the 57 AUs include 4 core courses, 4 prescribed electives, three practicum attachments, and either:

a dissertation

STUDENTS COMPLETING DISSERTATION

Students who are eligible for dissertation must write a research-based dissertation (6 AU) of between 12,000 to 15,000 words. They are required to complete 8 courses (24 AU) in total: 4 core courses, 2 prescribed electives in their area of specialisation and 2 elective courses (preferably recommended electives from their area of specialisation; and at least 1 elective must be in their chosen area of specialisation). The courses are 39 hours in duration (13 weeks x 3 hours). They are also required to complete three practicum placements (27 AUs), of which the first practicum must be completed in the students' workplace during the course of the student's first two semesters..

STUDENTS NOT COMPLETING DISSERTATION

Students who are not completing dissertation are required to complete 10 courses (30 AU) in total: 4 core courses, 2 prescribed electives in their area of specialisation and 4 elective courses (preferably recommended electives from their area of specialisation; and at least 2 electives must be in their chosen area of specialisation). The courses range from 13 hours (1 AU) to 52 (4 AUs) hours in duration. 1 AU courses are typically completed over 2 full 6.5 hour days in the week before or during the semester, while 3 and 4 AU courses will be conducted over 13 week semester. 4 AU courses often include skills practice and supervision. Apart from coursework, students are also required to complete three practicum placements (27 AUs), of which the first practicum must be completed in the students' workplace during the course of the student's first two semesters.

Note 1: Planning will have to take into account the availability of courses which will depend on staff availability and student demand.

Note 2: Practicum 1 @ Work lasts 1 full year for Full-time students and 2 years for Part-time students. Practicums 2 & 3 last 6 months each, from January to June and July to December. Practicum grades are always submitted in the following semester.

Note 3: Dissertation planning is not a formal course but it is included in the study plan (in brackets) to emphasise the importance of allocating time for this task.

Note 4: Students who obtain CGPAs of 4.25 and above for their 4 core subjects can choose between doing a dissertation or 2 electives. They must inform the Programme Leader of their decision as soon as possible. This decision is **not reversible**.

STUDY PLANS

The programme is designed to be completed in a maximum of 3.5 years for *full-time* candidates and a maximum of 4.5 years for *part-time* candidates who are eligible for dissertation. It is designed to be completed in a maximum of $2\frac{1}{2}$ years for *full-time* candidates and a maximum of $3\frac{1}{2}$ years for *part-time* candidates who do not write a dissertation.
